# INFOFLEX Booth Construction Rules and Regulations 

## Linear Booth

Linear Booths, also called "in-line" booths, are generally arranged in a straight line and have neighboring exhibitors on their immediate right, left or both sides leaving only one side exposed to the aisle.

## Use of Space

Regardless of the number of Linear Booths utilized, e.g. 10ft by $20 \mathrm{ft}(3.05 \mathrm{~m}$ by 6.10 m$), 10 \mathrm{ft}$ by $30 \mathrm{ft}(3.05 \mathrm{~m}$ by 9.14 m$)$, 10 ft by 40 ft ( 3.05 m by 12.19 m ), etc. display materials should be arranged in such a manner so as not to obstruct sight lines of neighboring exhibitors. The maximum height of $8 \mathrm{ft}(2.44 \mathrm{~m})$ is allowed only in the rear half of the booth space, with a $4 \mathrm{ft}(1.22 \mathrm{~m})$
 height restriction imposed on all materials in the remaining space forward to the aisle. te: When three or more Linear Booths are used in combination as a single exhibit space, the $4 \mathrm{ft}(1.22 \mathrm{~m})$ height limitation is applied only to that portion of exhibit space which is within 10 ft $(3.05 \mathrm{~m})$ of an adjoining booth

## Corner Booth

A Corner Booth is a Linear Booth at the end of a series of in-line booths with exposure to intersecting aisles on two sides. All guidelines for Linear Booths apply.

## Perimeter Booth

A Perimeter Booth is a Linear Booth that backs to an outside wall of the exhibit facility rather than to another exhibit.

## Dimensions and Use of Space

All guidelines for Linear Booths apply to perimeter Booths except that the typical maximum back wall height is 9 ft .

## End-cap Booth

An End-cap configuration is an in-line (linear) booth placed in the position of a Peninsula or Split Island. Line-of-Sight rules apply and not cubic content, this configuration must follow the dimensions below.

## Dimensions

End-cap Booths are generally 10ft (3.05m) deep by $20 \mathrm{ft}(6.10 \mathrm{~m})$ wide. The maximum back wall height allowed is $8 \mathrm{ft}(2.44 \mathrm{~m})$ and the maximum back-wall width allowed is $10 \mathrm{ft}(3.05 \mathrm{~m})$ at the center of the back-wall with a maximum
 side aisles, the maximum height for any display materials is $4^{\prime}$.


## Island Booth

## Dimensions

An Island Booth is typically 20 ft by $20 \mathrm{ft}(6.10 \mathrm{~m}$ by 6.10 m$)$ or larger, although it may be configured differently.

## Use of Space

The entire cubic content of the space may be used up to the maximum allowable height of 11 ft including signage.
